Accreditation Reviews

Bethel College (Indiana). Bethel College's business and business-related programs were accredited with notes and observations.

Bryan College (Tennessee). Bryan College's business and business-related programs were accredited with notes and observations.

Keuka College (New York). Keuka College's business and business-related programs were accredited with notes and observations.

Marian College (Indiana). Marian College's accreditation was extended until the Board of Commissioners can reconsider its accreditation status at the January 2007 meeting of the board.

Northwestern College (Iowa). Northwestern College's business and business-related programs were accredited with one note and with observations.

University of St. Mary (Kansas). The University of St. Mary's accreditation review was postponed until the January 2007 meeting of the Board of Commissioners.

Actions Concerning Previously-Postponed Institutions

Viterbo University (Wisconsin). Pending the implementation of actions requested by the Board of Commissioners, the accreditation of Viterbo University's business and business-related programs will be considered at the January 2007 meeting of the board. Viterbo's accreditation remains in place through 2008.

Centenary College (New Jersey). Centenary College's accreditation review was postponed until the January 2007 meeting of the Board of Commissioners.

Actions Concerning Candidacy of Institutions without U.S.-Based Regional Accreditation

Weller International Business School (Paris, France). Weller International Business School's request for candidacy was denied; Weller may ask for reconsideration once it provides evidence that it meets all candidacy requirements.

European University of Macedonia (Skopje, Macedonia). Admitted to candidacy.

Other Accreditation Issues

Judson College (Illinois): Accreditation suspended because of failure to provide required information.

Newbury College (Massachusetts). At the request of the institution, Newbury College's status was changed from accredited to candidate for accreditation.

Fisk University (Tennessee): Fisk University was granted an extension until November 1, 2006 to report actions taken on notes from the Board of Commissioners.

Nazareth College (New York): Nazareth's College's request for a site visit extension until Spring 2007 was approved.

Myers College (Ohio): Myers College's request for a site visit extension until Fall 2007 was approved.

Marian College of Fond du Lac (Wisconsin): Marian College of Fond du Lac's request for a site visit extension until Spring 2007 was approved.
