

LOURDES UNIVERSITY ACCOUNTING FACULTY POSITION

Lourdes University, a private, four-year, liberal arts university sponsored by the Sisters of St. Francis of Sylvania, Ohio, is seeking an accounting professional to fill a faculty position in the College of Business. This is a full-time, nine month position which will begin in fall 2012.

This position will teach a flexible combination of required courses (Principles of Financial Accounting and Principles of Managerial Accounting) and major requirements (Advanced Financial Accounting, Taxation, and Auditing). This position will also coordinate the undergraduate accounting major(s) and play an important role in expanding the undergraduate accounting program with a focus on C.P.A. preparation. The ideal candidate will also be capable of teaching select accounting and finance related courses in our M.B.A. and M.O.L. programs.

To be considered, candidates must possess one of the following degrees or degree combination: a Ph.D. in Accounting (or A.B.D. with imminent completion date), a J.D./C.P.A., or an M.B.A./C.P.A. Rank is dependent upon qualifications and experience. Previous teaching at the college/university level is highly desired. Experience in program development desired.

Lourdes University faculty members are expected to maintain academic qualifications consistent with accreditation standards for scholarship and intellectual contributions as well as fulfilling service obligations including college and school governance, academic advisement, professional development, and other needed activities.
